Rest of the day free to travel around on the System.

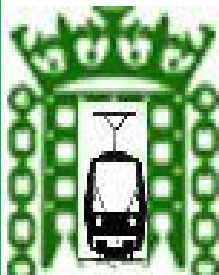

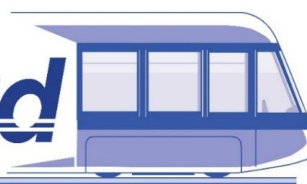
